1.2 Policy – Assessment

Rationale:

At Ross Intermediate School assessment is seen as an important system to inform students, teachers, parents/caregivers and the community on progress and the next step for students education.

Principles:

1. The principal will be responsible for ensuring that there is systematic reporting to the Board of Trustees on how learning programmes meet both school and National guideline requirements.
2. School expectations for curriculum assessment will be set out in the Staff Handbook. These will be reviewed annually.
3. Appropriate formative assessment procedures will be identified and utilized.
4. School-wide data will be collected and analysed throughout the year as per the assessment statement. This data will identify trends and concerns for Pacifica and Maori communication.
5. Assessment data will guide resourcing and school wide priorities.
