2.2 Policy – Strategic Planning

Rationale:

Strategic planning is a tool for setting school direction to ensure the best possible outcomes for children are achieved

Principles:

1. The board will revisit the strategic plan in November each year, review budget commitments and set targets for the coming year.
2. The board delegates to the Principal the development of an annual plan in line with the strategic plan.
3. The board delegates to the Principal the development of annual targets in consultation with the staff.
4. The Principal will report annually to the board on how the school has met the annual targets.
5. The principal or a delegated staff member will report student achievement to the Board and community.
6. The Board acknowledge the importance of basing all major decisions around the vision and values of the strategic plan.
